

# Announcement

## 47. Dr. Kleemann-Zuchtausleseprüfung from 8. Oktober until 11. Oktober 2026 in Merzen

(English version for information purposes only; german version officially binding)



The Kurzhaar Klub Artland-Emsland e.V. has kindly agreed to host the upcoming 47<sup>th</sup> Dr. Kleemann Zuchtausleseprüfung. Main area for the trials will be around Merzen, with grounds, water and fields located in Emsland and around Osnabrück.

**The Deutsch-Kurzhaar-Verband e. V. and the organizing club Kurzhaarklub Artland-Emsland e. V. are inviting all Kurzhaar enthusiasts to participate in the event.**

The test is open to all dogs registered in the Deutsch-Kurzhaar studbook fulfilling the following admission requirements below. Dog handlers must have a valid gunlicense.

### Qualification requirements:

(§2 PO Dr.-Kleemann-Zuchtausleseprüfung)

The dog

- must have achieved two 1. Prices at the three tests Derby, Solms or AZP, where by a single repetition for each test is allowed and Derby alone is not sufficient, however compulsory,
- must have passed a VGP in 1. Price
- must have conformation score of at least "SG" (very good) in the mature classification (Altersklasse),
- must have the toughness certificate (HN = Härtenachweis)
- Must have either a certificate for retrieve on natural wound track (Vbr) or passed a blood tracking test (VSwP)
- HD free (A1 - B2) und OCD free

**The admission requirements must be fulfilled by the entry date.**

Dogs, that were tested at the above mentioned tests (Solms, AZP and VGP) without the category "search behind the duck in water with dense cover" (partial test) due to existing special regulations or only passed the waterwork with a score lower than "very good" (sehr gut) in this category, must additionally prove their ability with a score of "very good" at a VBR-E.

The VBR-E certificate is only recognized for dogs from EU countries if it has been obtained in accordance with the European Bird Protection Directive during the country-specific hunting seasons for waterfowl and outside of breeding and rearing periods. The VBR-E certificate is only recognized if it is confirmed by the signatures of three association judges of the JGHV.

Dogs that showed signs of gunfire sensitivity at previous tests and or other behaviour faults or dogs with faults excluding them from breeding (Zuchtuntauglich) cannot take part.

Foreign dogs registered in a recognized foreign studbook can be admitted, providing that they fulfil the requirements of §2 (1) or comparable prerequisites and are admitted to the test by a board decision. A very high standard must be applied.

Foreign dogs must also have obtained breeding suitability in accordance with § 4 (9) (breeding suitability of dogs bred abroad) of the currently valid breeding regulations of the Deutsch Kurzhaar Verband before the entry deadline. Handlers from abroad who cannot provide proof of sufficient liability insurance for their dogs will be given the opportunity to purchase this at a low cost for the duration of the trial when registering at the trial office.

### Entries:

Entries should be sent via the president of each club, who will forward the entry to Mr. Andreas Thomschke, Ueberauer Str. 39, 64354 Reinheim. A foto will be requested of each dog for the catalogue. Please send foto via eMail (ideally in jpg-format), eMail: thomschke@kurzhaar.org or a.thomschke@web.de

Only postal entries will be accepted and must contain the application form signed by the applicant. No eMails or faxes will be accepted. The entry form must be completed fully, either digital or by the use of a typewriter. Please use the official entry form provided by the Kurzhaar Verband, which can be found here: [www.dk-verband.de](http://www.dk-verband.de)

A copy of a hunting license must be valid at the time of the 47<sup>th</sup> Dr. Kleemann Zuchtausleseprüfung has to be included with the entry.

Handwritten or partially completed entries (especially missing Chipnumber of the dog, missing eMail address or missing copy of the hunting license) can not be accepted.

For foreign dogs following copies must be included in the entry:

- Pedigree papers of the dog entered
- Proof of breeding suitability according to §4 (9) of the currently valid breeding regulations of the DK Verband (Zuchttauglichkeit im Ausland gezüchteter Hunde),
- Exam certificates (Zensurenblätter) of all previous exams including a german translation
- HD examination certificate with proof of being HD-free
- Hunting license/certificate valid at the time of the 47<sup>th</sup> Dr. Kleemann Zuchtausleseprüfung taking part including a german translation

### Note:

The requirements for this test are highly demanding. Only thoroughly trained dogs that have passed the required preliminary tests with very good results and have sufficient hunting experience should be entered to this trial.

### Closing entries: 01.07.2026

No later entries can be accepted.

### Entry fee: 240 €

**The entry fee must be transferred no later than the closing date for entries. Entries with late payments can not be accepted.**
